

Sustainability and ESG disclosure in Greece and worldwide

Sustainable policies and ESG disclosure (Worldwide)

U.S. and China are rated with

4.85/10, **5.71**/10 respectively. European countries pave the way for sustainable finance and ESG disclosure, given the strict national climate policies and the EU Directives; average score **7.93**/10.



Greece ranks low in environmental indicators. At the same time, in terms of governance there are significant shortcomings The average ESG score of the Greek companies remains below the global and European averages

UNSDG Performance (Greece)

Greece's performance overpasses the OECD Members' average. The country overperforms in

#SDG1 - No Poverty,

#SDG6 - Clean water and sanitation, #SDG10 - Reduced inequalities.

The average score of sustainable finance and ESG implementation policies worldwide is at 6.57/10



ESG Performance (Greece)

In 2020, **47%** of the Greek companies that report their ESG performance score from 0-50,

18% score from 50-70, while only **35%** report high sustainability performance.

Compared to the Mediterranean and central European countries
-average regional score of 77.2/100Greece lags behind by 0.4
